

NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH  
RE: MEDICAL DEVICE IMPORT FACILITIES,  
B.E. 2552 (2009)\*

---

By virtue of the provisions of section 5 and section 16 (8) of the Medical Devices Act, B.E. 2551 (2008) which contains certain provisions in relation to the restriction of rights and liberties of a person, in respect of which section 29 in conjunction with section 33, section 41, section 43 and section 45 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, so permit by virtue of law, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the Notification as follows.

**Clause 1.** An applicant for a medical device import establishment registration must prepare a place for storage of medical devices and equipment used for storage of medical devices as follows.

(1) A place for storage of medical devices must be kept clean and have sufficient light and air ventilation.

(2) Equipment used for storage and preservation of quality of each type of medical devices shall be made available in a number which is sufficient for the quantity of the medical devices.

(3) Each type of medical devices shall be separately kept according to their category.

**Clause 2.** This Notification shall come into force as from the date following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
